### 264 centers serve 272 institutions:

- The LGBTQ Student Resource Center serves the Community College of Denver, Metropolitan State University of Denver, & University of Colorado - Denver.
- The Queer Resource Center serves 7 institutions of the Claremont Colleges (CA).

### Center Type

- **175 (serving 167 campuses) Stand-alone LGBTQ center:** A space you can walk into whose sole-purpose is providing LGBTQ services or resources, directed by professional staff or a GA.
- **17 Within Women's or Gender Equity Office:** Office includes staff whose job description specifically focuses on LGBTQ concerns.
- **65 Within Cross-Cultural or Diversity Office:** Office includes staff whose job description specifically focuses on LGBTQ concerns.
- **15 Other:** Staff position is housed within Student Life, a Wellness Center, or some other office.

## Institution Attributes

- **11 Religiously-Affiliated Institution:** campus administration answers to a religious institution.
- **1 Historically Black College / University:** institutions of higher education in the United States that were established before the Civil Rights Act of 1964 with the intention of primarily serving the African-American community.
- **1 Women's College:** single-sex U.S. institutions of higher education that historically only admit female students.
- **14 Resources Directed by a Graduate Assistant:** a GA works 20 hours a week as the primary director of LGBT resources and services for the campus.
- **5 Student Government-Affiliated Center:** office space and budget part of Student Government.
